OVERVIEW





The 2013 Clean Energy Student Challenge will award more than \$160,000 in cash and prizes to the best student-generated clean energy business concepts in the Midwest.

This year, applicants from across the Midwest region will compete in 6 state-level competitions that will each award \$10,000 in cash prizes to the state-level winners. The winner of each state competition will advance to the regional Clean Energy Challenge where they will compete for a \$100,000 cash grand prize. Finalists in the Challenge will present to a distinguished panel of venture capitalists, corporate investors and business leaders at the regional competition on April 4th, 2013 in Chicago.

The Student Challenge grand prize winner will also earn the opportunity to compete for an additional \$100,000 grand prize, in the U.S. Department of Energy's second annual National Clean Energy Business Competition, in Washington, D.C. in the summer of 2013.
